
# **USEFUL INFORMATION**

#### **The Conference location**

The event will be held at **Politecnico di Milano**, Campus Bovisa-Candiani, Via Candiani 72 (main entrance), in buildings **B9** (Carlo de Carli room, exhibit, plenary sessions, coffee breaks and lunch) and **B8** (workshops and sessions on September 17).

The area hosts the Department of Design, a world top ranked academic institution, that has become an important hub of Milanese design.



NB: Pay attention when using google maps: Politecnico has more than one seat, the Conference is held in the Bovisa-Candiani Campus, entrance Via Candiani 72.

## How to reach the Conference location

The Department of Design of the Politecnico di Milano in the Bovisa area is easily accessible by car, train or via the urban public transport system.

#### Train:

The best way to get there is by train. The nearest train station to the Campus is the **Milano Bovisa-Politecnico** station where the 'passante ferroviario' (Lines S1, S2, S3, S4, S12, S13), the Malpensa Express (to/from the Milano Malpensa Airport) and several other lines coming from Milano Garibaldi or Milano Cadorna stations.

Trains available every 5'-10'.

To reach the main entrance of the Campus, exiting the Milano Bovisa Politecnico station, turn left and head toward Via Candiani.

### Subway (Metropolitana or just 'Metro'):

The nearest Metro station to the Campus is Dergano Station of the M3 - yellow line. It is about 2 km and 15 minutes' walk along Via Baldinucci, Via Maffucci and Via Candiani.

#### Surface lines:

The Campus is easily reached by using tram 2, getting off at the terminus in Piazza Bausan or by buses 82 and 92 getting off at the Bovisa-Politecnico stop located on Via Bovisasca. All stops are within 200 meters of the Campus entrance.

#### By car:

Parking available in the street around the Campus or in the parking in via Durando 38 or in Piazza Alfieri.

## How to reach Milan

**By train** to Milano Centrale or Milano Garibaldi stations, see websites like: <u>Rail Europe</u> The Trainline

#### By plane to one of the three airports serving Milan:

The airport closest to the city center is **Milano Linate** (by 'Metro' it takes 12' to the stop San Babila, just behind Piazza Duomo). To reach the Conference location then you have to change the line to go to the train station Milano Garibaldi and take the train to Milano Politecnico-Bovisa. Several airline companies are based at Linate.

The airport closest to the station Bovisa-Politecnico is **Milano Malpensa** (easyjet), with a direct train to the station Bovisa-Politecnico (it's called Malpensa Express) that take 30'-35'. It is advisable particularly when you leave, to shorten times.

**Milano Bergamo** (Ryanair) can be cheaper but is further away, you have to take the shuttle bus to Milano Centrale station (it takes 1h 10') and then the train to Milano Bovisa-Politecnico. It is advisable if you have time to spend, perhaps if you come already on Friday or Saturday, or if you have really good flight opportunities.

### Accommodation

There are plenty of accommodation opportunities in Milan, including Hotels and B&Bs. We advise you to use your favorite booking source or web platform to find the best solution according to your budget and habits.
