

#### End of Program

Turkish Patent Information User Group

Following an application to the CEPIUG Board, Turkey was unanimously accepted as the 11th member country after the 15th Anniversary Conference held in Milan in 2023.



The Turkish Patent Information User Group (TURPIUG) was established in 2024 with the aim of addressing the needs of patent information users in Turkey and Europe, representing them within CEPIUG, and promoting the strategic use of patent information.





As of 2024, TURPIUG has been operating as an official association. With approximately 100 official members and 2,000 LinkedIn followers, TURPIUG holds two physical and thematic meetings each year—one in Ankara during the spring term and one in Istanbul during the autumn term. It organizes regular webinars and meetings to boost the strategic use of intellectual property with the TURKPATENT and other local partners.



Through its four dedicated commissions—QPIP, Diaspora, Academia, and Digital Tools—TURPIUG has distinguished itself as the fastest-growing intellectual property association in Turkey. It also offers training to expand community of Turkish Qualified Patent Information Professional (QPIP) title holders.

#### • On Arrival & Registration
